

Since rain is practically nonexistent half the year, a sprinkler system can be a big help in getting water to your plants, and Pandora's Box presents this necessity in the form of flower-shaped sprinklers. The Flower Shower by Hart Art, a Tennessee-based husband and wife team, is a collection of both three-foot- and six-foot-tall, metal sprinkers that look like, well, giant flowers. Patina green "stalks" feature leaves hanging from copper wire, two standard on/off valves painted yellow, and large, brightly painted metal flowers surrounding a fully functional sprinkler, which is attached to the stand by an adjustable metal hose.
